

1979 CALIFORNIA QSO PARTY Sponsored by the Northern California Contest Club

THE CALIFORNIA QSO PARTY CONTINUES TO DOMINATE AT THE NUMERO UNO OF STATE LEVEL QSO PARTIES. DESPITE BELOW AVERAGE PROPAGATION, ACTIVITY WAS HIGH AND MANY RECORDS FELL TO OUTSTANDING PERFORMANCES BY INTREPID CQPERS. IT APPEARS THAT THE ONLY CLEAN SWEEPS SCORED WERE BY KB6FT (THE ONLY SINGLE OPERATOR TO DO SO) AND THE MULTIOP N6KT. IMPRESSIVE EFFORTS BY MOBILE AND PORTABLE OPERATIONS MADE IT POSSIBLE FOR OUT OF STATE STATIONS TO WORK ALL 58 CALIFORNIA COUNTIES. HOWEVER, THE CLOSEST ANYONE CAME WAS 53 COUNTIES BY OUR OUT OF STATE CHAMP, JERRY, K9BG.

DEAN STRAW, N6BV, CAME UP WITH A NEW ALL TIME RECORD SINGLE OPERATOR SCORE OF 232K WITH OVER 2000 QSOS! CLOSE ON HIS HEELS WAS ROB VANGEEN, WB6SHD, OPERATING N6RZ TO THE TUNE OF NEARLY 211K. IN THE SOUTH, KEVIN GLENN, KB6FT, REALLY PUT IT TOGETHER FOR A CLEAN SWEEP AND CLOSE TO 202K.

OUT OF STATE HONORS AGAIN GO TO JERRY, K9BG, WHO FINISHED WELL AHEAD OF THE REST OF THE PACK.

Topping the multioperator entries was N6KT, operated by N6KT, WA6VEF, K9LBQ, N6NE, WA6HCI, and WB6PYI. The previous N6KT multiop record was smashed with an incredible 4,258+ contacts on all bands 160 through 450 MHz, and a clean sweep, and nearly HALF A MILLION points, a score that will be tough to BEAT.
