

CQP 2026: Rules Updates

Following is a list of the rules updates for CQP 2026.

- 1. SSB QSOs are now worth 3 points (used to be worth 2 points).**
 - a. CW QSO value remains unchanged at 3 points.
 - b. Reason for change: see QSO Points section of [CQP FAQ page](#) for detailed explanation and charts.
 - c. We will work with logging software authors to implement this change prior to CQP 2026.

- 2. A minimum number of operators is required in Multi-operator entries.**
 - a. M/S and M/2 entries must have a minimum of two different transmitting operators over the 30-hour operating period.
 - b. M/M entries must have a minimum of three different transmitting operators over the 30-hour operating period.
 - c. For S/O and S/O-Assisted participants that continue to make QSOs beyond the maximum 24 hours of allowed operating time:
 - i. QSOs made after 24 hours of operating time will be unscored.
 - ii. Entry will remain S/O or S/O-Assisted.
