My attention was forced to 20 and 15 during the day, while 40 opened up in the evening. 80 meters provided a scattering of Qs, and 160m was plagued by noise and an intermittent feedline connection that reared its ugly head. I thought that problem had been resolved by replacing the cracked (weathered) center insulator a couple of weeks ago.

Sunday was a different story. Ten meters opened up as if a 1-1/2" hardline had been rolled out between our two states! One SSB station was 40-dB/S-9 and blew my ears out! Most stations were S9+ in the afternoon. There were a few instances of deep QSB that required some repeats, but overall, I felt the conditions were excellent on the second day. I worked all the counties except Trinity by early Sunday, but a sweep was not in the cards for me this year.

I had another "problem" that hampered me in copying serial numbers. I heard many stations on CW that were clipping the first part of their transmission. This often chopped most, if not all, of the first dot when they sent their serial number. This was more pronounced at higher CW speeds, of course. I suspect this could result from inadequate PTT timing, especially when an amplifier is involved in the RF string. And that issue can go undetected unless you have a separate monitor for the RF leaving the antenna!



Overall, this was a casual entry for me, but I really did enjoy operating this premier QSO Party. Many thanks to all the fellows out on the West Coast who coordinate this event each year.
